General information:

Project title: Communicating science and culture 3 (CSC3)

Duration: 4 weeks in total - 2 weeks online, 1 week face-to-face, 1 week online

Description: The project aims at developing students' transversal skills, also known as trasferable or soft skills (communication, presentation skills, problem-solving skills, teamwork, adaptability). They will be enhanced and practiced both in virtual - online and onsite environment, academic, as well as during more relaxed, free-time, sports and cultural activities.

Participants: This project involves interlingual and intercultural exchanges between students from several EUt+ Universities.

Classes:

Week 1: 15th September – 19th September 2025

Online sessions on Tuesday and Thursday from 17:00 to 18:30 CET

Week 2: 22nd September – 26th September 2025

Online sessions on Tuesday and Thursday from 17:00 to 18:30 CET

Week 3: 29th September – 3rd October 2025

Face-to-face sessions during Sofia week

Week 4: 6th October – 10th October 2025

Online sessions on Tuesday and Thursday from 17:00 to 18:30 CET

Languages: The course is taught in English (min. B1 level of CEFR) BUT you can CHAT in any of the languages of the participants. (; Students' local language and culture sessions are included;)

Assessment is based on individual and group work project based assignments and presentations. Students are expected to participate actively in the digital (online) part of the course, in the activities during the F2F week in Sofia, in the national and international working teams during the programme.

3 ECTS will be awarded.

Finances:

- You can apply for an Erasmus+ scholarship for your stay in Sofia, Bulgaria at your home university.
- Study materials and social programme are provided for by **TU-Sofia** (travel, accommodation cost and daily needs to be covered by the participants).
