He/ she is also aware of the fact that every time he/ she goes to the university premises he/ she confirms that:

- he /she has no flu symptoms or fever (over 37.5 ° C);
- has had no symptoms related to Sars-COV2 / COVID-19 infection in the last 14 days (fever, cough, changes in taste and smell, breathing difficulties);
- no one else in the family has the above symptoms;
- is not aware of having come into contact with any confirmed case of Sars-COV2 / COVID-19 infection in the last 14 days;
- does not come from an area at risk;
- has not been subjected to quarantine and / or isolation i.e. not to have been affected by COVID-19 (NB: in the case of having been affected by COVID-19 it is necessary to possess and exhibit on request a suitable medical certificate which proves that "negativisation has occurred" according to the envisaged procedures, issued by the competent territorial Prevention Department or other competent health authority).

The undersigned undertakes to check the onset of symptoms attributable to COVID-19 infection during the time spent on the premises of the University of Cassino and Southern Lazio, or situations of contact with confirmed cases of COVID-19, and to promptly communicate such eventualities to University staff.

Lastly, he/she is aware that presence on university premises is limited to didactic activities (lessons, exams, graduations) or access to offices, laboratories and libraries, in each case subject to appropriate reservation.

Legal basis of the processing

Art. 6 lett. e), of the European Regulation no. 679/2016: the execution of a task of public interest or connected to the exercise of public authority vested in the data controller

Purpose and description of the processing

The data is processed, in compliance with the regulatory framework in force by the University of Cassino and southern Lazio in order to:

- protect the health and safety of those concerned;
- keep under control the risk of spread of infectious diseases, and in particular of COVID-19;
- collect information necessary for the management of COVID-19 risk in the workplace;
- transfer to the National Health Service, exclusively following a written request, any data relating to potential contacts at risk of infection that has occurred at the University of Cassino and Southern Lazio.

The data will be used exclusively for the intended institutional purposes, within the scope of the provisions of laws, regulations or contractual rules.

Nature of personal data strictly necessary to pursue the described purpose. Common

personal data: name, surname;

Special categories of personal data: health data (body temperature, presence of flu symptoms, in particular, cough, cold, sore throat, burning eyes, difficulty in breathing).

Archiving and conservation

The data will be stored (in paper and digital format) for as long as necessary to achieve the aforementioned purposes, in accordance with national and European legislation (General (EU) Data Protection Regulation).

Notes on the rights of the interested party

We inform you that the interested party may ask the data controller, under the conditions, for access to personal data pursuant to art. 15 of the Regulations, the correction of the same pursuant to art. 16 of Regulation, the cancellation of the same pursuant to art. 17 of the Regulation (if the latter does not conflict with the current legislation on data retention and with the need to protect, in the event of a legal dispute, the University and the professionals who have processed them) or the limitation of processing pursuant to art. 18 of the Regulation, or may oppose their treatment pursuant to art. 21 of the Regulation, in addition to being able to exercise the right to data portability pursuant to art. 20 of the Regulation.

In case of violation of the provisions of the Regulations, the interested party may lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data, in accordance with current legislation.

Categories of interested parties

Workers, students, visitors and users

Categories of recipients

The data may be disclosed to third parties, in accordance with current national and European legislation. In particular to the internal offices, again for the same purposes listed above, and possibly to the National Health Service, exclusively following a written request.

Communication and transfer abroad

The data is not disclosed abroad.
