## <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u> (in updating)

### 1) Which Italian universities and courses have an agreement?

### 2) What is the first useful period for courses at the chosen university?

The second semester of the academic year 2024-25 is the useful period.

# 3) I have already applied for the European Erasmus programme for the first semester of A.Y. 2024-25. Can I also participate in the call for the Italian Erasmus programme in the second semester?

Yes, you can.

### 4) What are the languages used for the courses?

At the moment mainly Italian language, but some courses are in English and the list of courses is constantly updateding. It is student's responsibility to find out the minimum language level required by the university of destination

### 5) Is it possible to select more than one university as destination?

Yes, the students who are placed in the ranking list will identify, in agreement with UNICAS, the definitive university and course of destination.

### 6) What is the timeframe for the final ranking with the winners?

The ranking list will be released in time for the activation of the programme in the second semester of 2024-25

## 7) Does the programme only include taking exams or a semester of studying at the destination university?

The programme has the same educational requirements for UNICAS students as for students at the university of destination, so it is advisable for UNICAS students to enquire in advance and directly at the university of destination of their choice.

8) Is admission to the call for applications compulsory or is it possible to decide not to apply once you have been usefully placed in the ranking list?

The student who has been placed in the ranking list has 15 days to confirm his or her participation in the programme from the date of publication of the list.

9) Are there further steps once the studente has completed the application form?

Possible further steps will be communicated to students admitted to the benefits of the call.

10) Can a student who does not have a calculable average (for example he/she has only exams with "suitable" or "pass") participate in the call for applications?
