3. How to submit

The application form must be COMPLETED DIGITALLY from the candidate's university account only (... @ studentmail.unicas.it) and through the online Students Secretary system GOMP (international mobility) by **10 FEBRUARY 2022**.

It is specified that it is not possible to change the application after its sending.

Compulsory documents to submit:

- a) GOMP application form
- b) one of the following attestations: 1) result of the foreign language exam in your study plan; 2) certificate of knowledge of the language accepted by the host organization; 3) acceptance letter ([facsimile](#)) in which the organization declares that the candidate has adequate knowledge of the required language;
- c) training project (Learning Agreement for traineeship), agreed with the host organization and the president of the relevant course of study, signed by all parties (company, president of the course of study, student).
- d) only for PhD students, authorization to participate in the Erasmus + program for traineeship issued by the coordinator of the relevant PhD course;
